Payment secure and keep the said Tobacco as he would doe his own proper Goods untill such person as did receive or is owner of the same shall send for it provided all ways that nothing in this act contained shall be construed meant or intended to make any Inhabitant or house keeper liable to any damage which shall happen to any Tobacco so left with him to keep and secure through any Casualty whatsoever.

And Be it further enacted by and with the advice and consent aforesaid that every Inhabitant house keeper or other person having a plantation as aforesaid and on a being Tobacco as aforesaid which shall not erect build or fitt up such house or houses upon their respective plantations for the uses and by the time aforesaid shall forfeit and pay the sume of five hundred pound of tobacco in cash the one half to the Lord Proprietory the other halfe to the Informer or him or them that shall sue for the same to be Recovered by bill plaint or Information in any Court of Record within this Province wherein no Losour wager nor protection in Law to be allowed This act to continue for three years or to the end of the next Generall Assembly which shall first happen

An Act relating to the seizure of Tobacco by the Sheriff
