

fiere facias or *Ulegit* (at the Election of the said Creditors) for the Recovery of the said debts as aforesaid any Law Statute or Customs to the contrary notwithstanding provided that His Lordships Justices doe call before them both parties and witnesses for due proof of the Justness of the said debt & of the said Sheriffes Seizure as aforesaid and that as in all other Civil Causes in his Lordships Courts the party last shall satisfy the costs and Court charges And that no Sheriff within this Province shall seize or mark any persons Inhabiting within this Province their Tobacco houses or Tobacco hanging or unstript or unpacket but only Tobacco packet in cash for any rent or leavys nor shall he mark any Merchant or others hogheads of Tobacco Received marked or nailed as aforesaid and remaining in the houses of any person within this Province undispoused of by the Merchant for any Cause or thing whatsoever but only for Rent & leavys And any Sheriff so seizing or marking any Tobacco houses or seizing any hogheads of Tobacco containing more than what is Justly due to his Lordship or publick for Rent or Leavys shall pay for every such default the sume of two thousand pounds of Tobacco the one half to the Lord Proprietary the other half to the party grieved to be Recovered by action at Law bill plaint or Information in any Court within this Province in which no protection Cosoyne or wager of Law to be allowed This act to endure for three years or to the end of the next Generall Assembly which shall first happen

An Act For the publication of Marriages

Be it Enacted by the Right Hon^{ble} the Lord Proprietary by and with the advice and Consent of the upper & lower houses of this present Generall Assembly that all persons who shall desire marriage have liberty to apply themselves either to a priest minister pastor or Magistrate for the contracting thereof And Be it further Enacted by the authority aforesaid that all persons within this Province intending marriage shall make publication thereof
