Secretary Judge of Probate or wills. Surveyor General all
Sheriff Coroners and Clerks of the Courts to Recover the
sumes by way of Execution against the goods or body of
the person so refusing and no other and in case any
shall be contrary directly or indirectly to this act
shall lose and forfeit to the party grieved triple
damages and shall also forfeit the sume of 1000 pounds
and pounds of Tobacco or forty pounds Sterling for every
time he or they shall sue to the contrary the one mony
due to the Lord Proprietary his heirs and Successors
the other moneys to the party or parties that shall sue
for the same by any plaint upon suit bill or Informa-
tion wherein no Envoys Protection or waige of Law
Shall be allowed Provided always that if any fees
for any matter or thing hereafter to be done belonging
to their several Office or Offices and by the Right
Honble the Lord Proprietary or his Lieutenant and
Gouvernour and Council so allowed and adjudged
and not in this act mentioned Limited and
allowed then it shall be Lawfull to have and
Receive such fees as the Lord Proprietary and
Council shall Judge and allow and no more
under the penality aforesaid to be Recovered
as aforesaid

An Act For assessment of the Inhabitants of this
Province in suits at law for small Debts
Whereas the Inhabitants of this province have been much
grieved molested and troubled by being forced by Provinciall
writs to appear at the Provinciall Courts and fee Attorneys
there notwithstanding the debts for are very small and
within the Cognizance of the County Courts of this Pro-
vince for the prevention whereof for the future the Bur-
goesses and delegates of this present General Assembly
doe humbly pray that it may be enacted And Be it
enacted By the Right Honble the Lord Proprietary
and with the advice and consent of the upper and
lower houses of this present General Assembly &
the authority of the same That from and after the
Publication hereof no action for a book debt or for a
plain bill for or under the sume of fifteen hundred
Pounds of Tobacco and Cash shall be commenced or
prosecuted against any Inhabitant of this Province
in the Provinciall Courts except only upon appeals
from
