the Subjects of this present Generall Assembly The
 Malitia of this province shall be mustered trained and
 exercised according to these Instructions and direc-
 tions following

First

That every Collonell Major or Captaine of foote already
 commisioned or hereafter to be commisionated by
 his Lordship his heirs or Successors Lords and Propri-
 etaries of this Province for the time being shall
 have power to inlist such and so many men In-
 habiting within this Province not hereafter excepted
 in their Severall and respective divisions between
 Sixteen and sixty years of age as they shall think
 fitt by an equall proportion of the said Inhabitants
 as possible they can to be of the Malitia or trained
 bands of this Province which said persons soe
 inlisted they shall muster exercise and traine
 up at such places and at such certain times as to
 them shall seem meet or the service safety & defence
 of this Province shall require or his Lordship the
 Lord Proprietary of this province his heirs or Successors
 or his or their Lieutenant Generall or chief Governour
 or Lieutenant Generall or chief Governour & Councill
 for the time being shall so cause to order

That every such Collonell Major or Captain shall
 give notice or Summons upon every trayning or
 mustering to every person soe inlisted as aforesaid
 within his Respective division or Simitts at
 the head of his Company or at the house of the
 party by an officer of his Company or a warrant
 under his hand to appear at such time and place
 as he shall appoint for such trayning & mustering
 and that if any man after such Notice or Summons
 given as aforesaid shall Neglect or Refuse to appear
 at the time and place appointed as aforesaid or that
 shall refuse when he hath so appeared to be inlisted
 into the Malitia or trained bands as aforesaid or that
 being so inlisted shall not from time to time as he shall
 be summoned and warned as aforesaid appear and
 bring with him one good serviceable fixed Gunn &
 Six Shott of powder shall for every such offence if a
 freeman forfeit and pay the Summe of one hundred
 pounds of Tobacco to the Lord Proprietary & if a
