from hence forth all such necessary charges of such war
and soldiers Pay as aforesaid shall be paid discharged
and defrayed by a publick heavy by an equal assessment
upon the Taxable^s of this Province by the Consent of the
freemen of this Province by their Representatives &
in a general Assembly and no otherwise whatsoever
according to the clause in an act entitled an Act of
gratitude to his Excellency Charles Calvert Esq^r Captain
General of Maryland

And to the end that the Inhabitants of this Province
may not be abused by having their goods and provisions
prest from them by loose and Idle fellows who many
times abuse their Comissions and the People Be
it enacted by the authority aforesaid that from hence
forth the Commissioners of each respective County
within this Province shall yearly and every year $\frac{1}{3}$ between
the nine and twentieth day of September
and the five and twentieth day of December nome
note and appoint two honest & substantial men
of their Counties for every hundred to be prefe^rmasters
for the year ensuing and if any one dye or depart
the Country or be lame or sick within that time That
then the next Justice of Peace to nominate and ap-
point another in his stead that if occasion require
they and none else shall imprese virtualls or other
things given them in charge to be preserved by
warrant from the Lord Proprietary his heirs or
successors or his or their Lieutenant General and
Governour for the time being And if any other but
such prefe^rmaster so appointed shall force
upon pretence of any power as a prefe^rmaste^r
master to seize take pefs or carry away any
goods or contrabuties of any the Inhabitants of
