

and whatsoever is necessary for the well Ruling & Government thereof and also upon any necessary and urgent occasions to raise and levy money for the defraying the charges of the said Government and defence thereof neither of which according to the Constitution of this Province can be made, ordered, established, levied or raised but by and with the Consent of the Freemen of this Province by their severall delegates and Representatives by them freely nominated chosen and elected to serve for their severall Cities and Counties in a Generall Assembly and for as much as the safest and best Rule for this Province to follow in collecting such delegates & Representatives is the precedent of the Proceedings in Parliament in England as near as the Constitution of this Province will admit the Delegates of this present Generall Assembly do humbly pray that it may be enacted and Be it enacted by the Right Hon^{ble} the Lord Proprietary by and with the advice and consent of the upper and lower houses of this present Generall Assembly and the authority of the same That for the future when and as often as his Lordship the Lord Proprietary his heirs and Successors his or their Deputies and chief Governour for the time being shall upon any accident and urgent affaire of this Province think fitt and convenient to call and convene an Assembly and to send out writts for the Election of Burgesses and Delegates to serve in such Assembly The forme of the said writt shall be as followeth

C. Absolute Lord and Proprietary of the provinces of Maryland an Avalon, Lord Baron of Baltimore To The Sheriff of St. Georges these are to authorize & require you immediately upon receipt hereof to call together four or more of the Commissioners of your County with the Clerk who are hereby required to sitt as a Court and during their sitting by virtue of your office to make or cause to be made publick Proclamation thereby given notice to all the freemen of your said County who have within your said County a freehold of fifty acres of Land or a visible personall estate of forty pounds Sterling at least Requiring them to appear at the next County Court to be holden
