Tobacco shall also pay and forfeit for every such default to the Lord Proprietary the like sume of five hundred pounds of Tobacco one half thereof to his said Lordship and the other half to him or them that shall informe and sue for the same and leave his debt so unjustly charged as aforesaid the said forfeiture to be recovered in any Court of Record in this Province wherein no Especial Protection or wager of Sane to be allowed And to the intent that all persons Inhabitants Travellers and Strangers as aforesaid may be certain of sufficient accommodation for themselves and horses Be it enacted by the authority aforesaid That every ordinary keeper or Innholder so to be licenced as aforesaid shall within six months after granting these respective Licences bear and are hereby obliged to provide and maintaine accomodation of oates hay and straw for Sitter and Indian come together with Stable Room convenient and sufficient for twenty horse at the least under the penalty of the forfeiture of paying the sume of ten thousand pounds of Tobaccoone half to the Lord Proprietary the other half to the Informer or him or them that shall sue for the same to be recovered by bill of plaint or Information in which no Especial protection or wager of Sane to be allowed Provided alwayes that no person or persons so licenced or to be licenced keep ordinary as aforesaid shall during the time of such their keeping Ordinary be Justices of the Peace or Commissioners in any County Court within this Province nor Maj. Record or nor Alderman of the said City of S' Maries anything in this act to the contrary notwithstanding.

And it is hereby enacted by the authority aforesaid that any ordinary keeper keeping will rule & order in his house and suffering extraordinary drinking fighting and Quarrelling in his house upon complaint made thereof to the Justices of the County Court of such ordinary keepers misbehaviour of himself or keeping will rule in their house the said Justices of the said County Court may and are hereby authorized & impowered to suppose such ordinary & call in such licence

And Be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid that any ordinary keeper disabled or impeded as aforesaid or any other person that shall presume to keep ordinary without Licence first had and obtained as aforesaid shall for every month he or they
