And Be it Enacted by the authority aforesaid  
that where any Judgment is had in any County Court for  
any matter or thing whatsoever and after such Judgment  
had and obtained the party against whom the same is  
had many times flies into another County out of the  
Jurisdiction of the said County Court it shall & may be  
lawfull for the said party to procure a certificate from the said  
Justices of such parties flying and thereupon the Jus-  
tices of the Provinciall Court shall award Execution against  
the body or Goods of the said party any Law Statute or  
usage to the contrary in anywise notwithstanding

And Be it further enacted by the authority  
aforesaid that any bills bonds or other Specialties book  
debts or accounts proved before two Justices of the peace  
of any county or any one Justice of the Provinciall Court  
and Just Credit given to the same and that the ballance  
thereof is wholly due and unpaid and so certified  
under the hand of the said Justices shall be sufficient  
Evidence as well in the Provinciall as County Courts within
