An Act For payment and adjusting
the publick charges of this province

Whereas there hath been eight hundred twenty five thousand
and nine hundred seventy nine pounds of Tobacco
expended laid out and disbursed by severall of the Inha-
bitants of this province in the late expedition against
the orantioke Indians and other the receyved charges
of this Province which hath been examined stated and
allowed by the upper and lower houses of this present
General Assembly To the Intent thereof that the same may
be satisfied and paid to those persons to whom the same
is due Be it Enacted by the right Honble the Lord Proprietary
by and with the advise and consent of the upper & lower
houses of this present General Assembly and the au-
thority of the same That the said eight hundred twenty
five thousand nine hundred seventy nine pounds of
Tobacco be paid in manner and forme as is hereafter ex-
prefed by an equall assessment upon the persons and
Estates of the Inhabitants of this province and be paid to
the severall persons to whom the same is due as aforesaid
any law Statute custom or usage to the contrary thereof
notwithstanding That is to say To Captain William
Hemsley Sixteen hundred pounds To Thomas Collins
