Proprietary with the advice & assent of the upper and
lower houses of this present Generall Assembly and the

mounting in the whole to the summe of eight hundred
twenty six thousand nine hundred seventy nine pounds
of Tobacco be levied and assessed by and equall Assessment
upon the Body or Estates of the Inhabitants Taxables of
this Province and paid to the severall persons to whom the
same is due as aforesaid Any Law Statute usage or
Custom to the contrary thereof notwithstanding
