An Act concerning a Register of Births, Marriages & Burials.

Be it Enacted by ~~the~~ Lord Prop^{ty} by and with y^e consent of this present gen^l Assembly, That y^e Names of all that shall be born, marryed and Buried within this Province, shall be exhibited to y^e Clerke of every respective County Court, who shall keep a Just Register thereof; who shall be allowed Five P^{er} of Tobacco as a fee due unto him for every such Register made and kept. And every person infringing y^e said Law for the space of Two months after such Birth, marriage or Buriall, each person so infringing shall forfeit Twenty Pounds of Tobacco to the said Clerke. This Act to continue for three years, or to the end of the next gen^l Assembly, and no longer.
