

speedily satisfied: then shall the person so offending suffer imprisonment four months, without Baile or mainprize.

And Be it further Enacted, ~~by~~ by y<sup>e</sup> authority aforesaid, that whosoever shall be summoned by writ, out of any Court of Justice of this Province to serve as Juror in any try-  
all, in any Courts within this Province, and shall refuse to serve in any case depending, whether Criminal or Civill, not being by any other office exempted, and thereto lawfully re-  
quired, shall forfeit to y<sup>e</sup> Lord Prop<sup>r</sup> and his heirs, five hundred Pounds of Castles Tobacco, or the value thereof to be Levied upon his goods and Chattells. And if any Person so offending, shall not have goods and Chattells within the Province, to satisfy y<sup>e</sup> aforesaid penalty, or that the same be not speedily satisfied: then shall the person so offending suffer two months imprisonment without Baile or mainprize.

And Be it further Enacted by y<sup>e</sup> authority aforesaid, that whosoever, being by writ lawfully summoned, & there-  
by required to serve as witness, within this Province; and shall refuse to testify upon oath in any Case depending, whether Criminal or Civill, shall forfeit to y<sup>e</sup> Lord Prop<sup>r</sup> five hundred Pounds of Tobacco, to be Levied upon his or their goods and Chattells. And if any person so offending, shall not have goods and Chattells, within this Province, sufficient to satisfy y<sup>e</sup> aforesaid penalty, or that the same be not speedily satisfied, then shall the person so offending suffer two months imprisonment without Baile or mainprize.

Provided That this Act, nor any thing therein contained shall not extend, nor be interpreted to extend to y<sup>e</sup> prejudice of any of y<sup>e</sup> Lords of Mannors within this Province, in their privileges of appointing Constables in their respective manors.
