An Act for Continuing the payment
of the imposition of Two Shillings p^c Hhd, during
the life of y^e hon^{ble} Cecilius Calvert
Esq^r, son and heir of the R^t hon^{ble} Charles
absolute Lord and Prop^{ty} of the Province of
Maryland, Lord ^{Ba}ltimore, in case he surviue
his Lordsh^r.

Whereas by an act of Assembly made at a gen^e
Assembly held at y^e City of St. Marys the 12th day of Feby
in y^e year of our Lord God 1674 Entituled An act of gra-
titudes to his Excellency Charles Calvert Esq^r Capt^r gen^e
of Maryland, it was Enacted That a former act made at
a gen^e Assembly held at y^e said City of St. Marys the 27th
day of March 1671, Entituled An Act for the raising &
providing a Support for his Lord^r y^e Lord and Prop^{ty} of
this Province, during his naturall Life; and Likewise a Supply
towards y^e defraying the publick charges of Government: It was
Enacted That y^e s^r act, and all and every y^e articles, Provisions,
matters and things therin contained, should stand and be, by
that present act ratified and confirmed to all intents and
purposes, according to y^e true intent and meaning thereof, not
only for and during the life of y^e R^t hon^{ble} Cecilius ab-
solute Lord and Prop^{ty} of this Province, and for one year after
as aforesaid; but also for and during y^e naturall life of y^e
R^t hon^{ble} Charles Calvert Esq^r son and heir apparent of
y^e R^t hon^{ble} Cecilius Lord Prop^{ty} and no longer; and That from
after y^e decease of y^e R^t hon^{ble} Cecilius Lord Prop^{ty}, the duty and
imposition of Two Shillings p^c Hhd (in y^e s^r act mentioned) shoul-
be Laid, Raised, Collected and Payed to y^e R^t Charles Calvert
Esq^r, for and during y^e terms of his naturall life as aforesaid
in such
