

as he shall think fit, untill such person or persons seized or apprehended, shall give sufficient security to answer the promises, the next Court that shall first ensue, in the said County: who is also to secure such person or persons, untill he or they can make satisfaction to the Party that shall so apprehend or seize such Runnaway, or other person, as by this Act is required: except such person shall make satisfaction, as aforesaid, before such Court shall happen. And that Notice may be conveniently given to the master, Mistress, or Dame of any Runnawayes taken up, as aforesaid: The Justices of the Peace, or Commissioners of the County, shall forthwith cause a note of the Runnaway's name, so seized & apprehended, as aforesaid, to be set up at y<sup>e</sup> County Court, where such party is seized or apprehended, as aforesaid, and also cause a note to be set up at y<sup>e</sup> next adjacent County Courts, & at the Prob<sup>all</sup> Court, or Secretary's Office: that all persons may view the same, and see where such their servants are, and in whose custody. And furthermore for the better ascertaining of what each servant, according to y<sup>e</sup> custom of the Countrey shall have, at the expiration of y<sup>e</sup> time of their servitude: Be it Enacted by the authority, advice, and consent aforesaid, that every man, servant, shall, at such time of expiration of his servitude aforesaid, have allowed and given him a good Cloath suite; either of Kersey, or broad Cloath: a shirt of white Linnen, to be new: one new pair of shoes and Stockings: Two Linnen: One ago: and Three Barrels of Indian Corn. All women, servants, at the time of y<sup>e</sup> expiration of their servitude, as aforesaid, shall have allowed, and given them the like provision of Cloath and Corn,
