

and Corn, as aforesaid. And to the intent the many great  
 mischiefs and Inconveniences, arising and accruing to diverse  
 good people of this Province, by the transporting, and carrying,  
 or conveying away; or causing to be transported, carried,  
 or conveyed away, out of this Province, any Inhabitant within  
 this Province, whether master or freeman, not thereto  
 Lawfully Licensed: or any apprentice, tynd, or other ser-  
 vant, or Slave; may (for the future) be prevented: Be it  
 further Enacted by the authority aforesaid, by and with  
 the advice and consent aforesaid, That every person or persons  
 that shall so transport, carry, or convey away, or cause  
 to be transported, carried, or conveyed away, out of this  
 Province, any Inhabitant of this Province, as aforesaid; that  
 is, or shall be indebted, or engaged here, and not having  
 a sufficient License or Pass, according to the Law of this  
 Province, in that case made and provided, shall be liable  
 to satisfy all <sup>such</sup> debts, engagements, & damages, as the said  
 person or persons so transported, carried or conveyed away  
 should be liable to satisfy, in convenient time: or that  
 in short time, he cause and procure such person or persons  
 so carried & conveyed away, to return again into this  
 Province: whereby he may be liable to Justice here: And  
 any Person, or Persons, that shall (from henceforth) on-  
 stitute, transport, carry, and privately convey, out of  
 this Province, any apprentice, tynd, or other servant  
 or Slave, belonging to any Inhabitant in this Province,  
 shall, for every such offence, forfeit and Pay to the  
 Employer, and Owner of such apprentice, tynd, or other  
 servant, or Slave, treble damages and costs; to be judged  
 by the Justices of each respective County Court: or if Justice  
 of the Probate Court, for the time of such apprentice, tynd
