

to the determination of the Court; but also forfeit the sum of One Thousand Pounds of Tobacco, to y^e Lord People for depriving the Court of such opportunity of knowing y^e Party: And if any Master, or Servant aforesd, be griev'd with y^e determination of y^e Court; he shall (within the time determined for their service) produce an Authentick Certificate of such Servants age, and shall have remedy to the ages aforesd, mentioned. And Be it further Enacted, by y^e authority: by and with the advice and consent aforesd, That no Indenture made by any Servant; during the time of service due by Indenture, or by determination of the Court, according to y^e tenour of this Act, shall (any wayes) oblige any servant for longer time, than by his first Indenture, or determination of y^e Court, shall be Limited, ~~or~~ appointed. Provided That this Act, nor any thing therein contained, shall be construed to give any benefit to any Slave whatsoever. Provided That neither this Act, nor any thing therein contained; Repeal, or be construed to Repeal, an Act made at a gen^l Assembly y^e 13th day of April 1674, Entituled, An Act concerning Servants that have Pastures, and for Encouragement of our neighbouring Colonies of Virginia, Delaware, and the Northern Parts of America, for taking up of Servants, and other Runaways out off this Province, into those parts.

Be it further Enacted, by the authority, advice & consent aforesd, y^e y^e sume of 400 Pounds of Tobac. shall (from henceforth) be allowed and payd to any person in those Colonies of Virginia, Delaware, and y^e Northern parts of America, that shall so seize or take up such Servants, or other Runaways; and carry, or cause them
