

People of this Province, by the Indians: and of great danger
the Province, and the Inhabitants thereof are exposed to,
by frequent incursions and invasions of the common
Enemy, the Indians: and to the intent, that some speedy
Course may be taken, for the safety and defense of
this Province, and the Inhabitants thereof, against the
said Indians: And forasmuch as of Exercise, & Training
up of Soldiers, in the event of Warre, and Military Disci-
pline, is (at all times) most necessary, to put us to keep
us in a good posture of defense agt our Enemies; and
yet, at this time of danger, very much neglected; to
the endangering of the whole Province: And for the settling
& ascertaining the charge of any wars that may hap-
pen, within this Province; They humbly Pray, that
it may be Enacted: and Be it Enacted, by the Lord
Prop. of this Province, by, and with the advice & consent
of the Upper & Lower Housrs of this present genl Assembly,
& the authority of the same, That every Colonell, Captain,
or major, within this Province, already Commissionated,
or hereafter to be Commissionated, by his Lordpp, or his
Heires, or Successors, Lords and Prop. of this Province,
or his, or their Lieutent, or Chiefe Governeur of this
Province, for the time being; shall have power to Enlist
such, and so many persons, inhabiting within this
Province, in their several, & respective Divisions, Between
Sixteen, and Sixty years of age, as they shall think
fitt to be of the militia, or Trained Bands of this Pro-
vince. Which Persons so Enlisted, they shall muster,
Exercise, and Train up, at such certain Places, and at
such certain times, and as often, as to them shall seem
meet; or for the service, safety, and defense of this Province
