 y^e 20th day of this instant June, no Indian Corn, wheat, Peas,
 Oats, or Barley, be exported or attempted to be exported out of
 this Province, wthout Leave first had & obtained of y^e R^t Hon^{ble}
 y^e Lord Prop^{ty}, his heirs and success^{rs}, or his or their Lieuten^{ts}
 or chief governo^r of this Province for the time being, under his
 or their hands and seals, upon pain and forfeiture of all such
 Corn so attempted to be transported out of this Province, either
 by Land, or water: and if by water, of y^e shipp and vessel
 or boat, in w^{ch} y^e same shall be attempted to be transported,
 wth all her apperrell, Tackles and furniture to them belonging
 y^e one halfe thereof to be to y^e R^t Hon^{ble} y^e Lord Prop^{ty}, his heirs
 & success^{rs}, the other halfe to him y^e shall inform, seize, or sue
 for the same, in any Court of record wthin this Province, by
 acc^on of debt, bill, plaint, or inform^on: wherⁱⁿ no essoy,
 protection or w^{ag}er in Law to be allowed. This Act to endure
 for one year, and no longer.
