

Be it Enacted by and with the advice and consent aforesaid, and the authority of the same, That all male Children Born within this Province, and resident in it, shall be taken and accounted Taxables at y^e age of 16 years & upwards: and all males, whether imported into this Province, at y^e age of 16 years and upwards, shall be accounted Taxables: and all slaves whatsoever, whether male or female, imported or born in this Province, at, or above y^e age of 16 years, shall be accounted Taxables, and so Rated: and that all freemen in this Province, except Ministers and Priests, & such poor and impotent persons that receive alms from the County, shall be Taxables, above y^e age of 16 years. This Act to endure for three years, or to y^e end of y^e next gen^l assembly w^{ch} shall first happen.

An Act to prevent the unnecessary delays of Executions

Forasmuch as his Lord^{sh} good people of this Province now more commonly holden from their just debts, and after in danger to lose the same, by means of writs of Error, and Appeals, which are more commonly sued than heretofore they have been. For provision whereof for y^e future,

Be it Enacted by the Right h^{ch} the Lord Prop^{ty}, by and with y^e advice & consent of y^e upper & lower houses of this present gen^l Assembly, & y^e authority of y^e same, That from and after y^e end of this present session, of gen^l Assembly, no Execution upon any judgment in any Court of Record in this Province shall be stayed or delayed by any writ of Error, or Appeals from the County Courts of this Province; or any Supersedeas upon any such writs of Error, or appeals, shall be sued out for y^e reversing of such Judgements
