 then presents, or other Judges, in his or their best discretion,
 shall think fitt. And the Constable in every hundred,
 taking one other sufficient able man along with him, shall
 view every mans Crops; and for his pains therein, shall
 be allowed and paid by every respective offendor against
 this present Act, fifty pounds of tobacco for every acre
 that he shall be short of that proportion aforesaid, re-
 spectively to be divided equally betwixt the said Constable
 and the person so assisting him, as aforesaid.

An Act of Gratitude to his Excellency Charles
 Calvert Esq^r. Capt. gen^l. of Maryland.

Whereas by an Act made at a gen^l. Assembly held
 at the City of S^t. Maries the 27th. day of march, in the
 39th. year of his Lapps dominion over this Province: anno
 Dom. 1671. Entituled An Act for the raising & providing
 a support for his Lopp the Lord & Prop^r. of this Province
 during his naturall life; and likewise a supply towards
 the defraying the publick Charges of government; it was Enacted
 that from and after the first day of September then next coming
 there should be raised, Levied, collected and payd unto y^e.
 Lopp, y^e. heirs and Successors, Lords and Prop^r. of this
 Province, the sume of two shillings sterling for every hhd
 & quantity of a hhd of tobacco wch. should be at any time
 then after shipped in any Ship or vessell, to be exported
 out of this Province, or any the territorios, Islands, Ports,
 Rivers, Creeks or Places therunto belonging: and it was
 also thereby Enacted, that the said duty & imposition
