 information in any the Courts of record within this Province
 Provided always that one halfe of the money by that
 Act to be raised, should be employd towards y^e maintaining
 a constant magazyn, with armes and ammunition for the
 defence of this Province, and defraying other publick ne-
 cessary Charges of the government. Provided always
 that so long as the said Act should continue, no publick
 Levie should be laid upon the Freemen & Inhabitants
 of this Province, but by consent of the said Freemen
 in open Assembly first had and obtained: and that during
 the Continuance of the said Act as aforesaid the last Clause
 of an Act entituled an Act concerning Levying warre,
 within this Province: by w^{ch} Clause It is enacted that all
 Charges arising from time to time by defence of this Province
 against any invasions of any enemy or enemies, or against
 any domestick insurrections or rebellions against y^e publick
 peace of this Province, or y^e government established therein
 under y^e Loopp and y^e heirs should be defrayed by y^e province
 by an equall assessment upon y^e persons & estates of the
 inhabitants thereof, should be & remain suspended, any
 thing in that Act to the contrary notwithstanding, the fore-
 going Clause in that Act remaining still in full force
 & vertue: Provided also that so long as y^e said Act
 should continue, y^e Looppes Receiv^{er} or Receiv^{er}s gen^l for the
 time being should receive good, sound & merchantable tobacco
 when tendered, for y^e Looppes Rents or Rents for alienation
 of Lands reserved upon the severall & respective grants
 of Land in this Province at the rate of two pence p^{te}, any
 thing in his Looppes grant to the contrary hereof notwith-
 standing. Provided also and it was thereby Enacted, that y^e Act
 entituled
