

Leabid, Raised, Collected and Payd to the R^t hon^eble Chas
Calvert Esq^r, for and during the tyme of his naturall life
as aforesaid, in such maner, and under such paine, penaunce
and forfeitures as by the said recited act is limited, and
appointed to be payd to the said Cecilius Lord Proprietary aforesaid.
Provided always notwithstanding that all
and obey the sevrall provisoes in the said act contained
doe durong the continuance of this act stand in full force
and vertue and be inseparably annexed to this present
act. Provided also that from and after y^er 1660
of this present session of gen^ll assembly in case of
Shipwreck or taking of any ship or shipp, Vessell or
Vessells soe that the tobaccoes soe laden and lost as aforesaid
shall be Repayd the said duty or imposition of two shillings
per hhd; or habe liberty to shipp at some other time so many
hhd^s tobacco as they had formerly payd imposition mony as
aforesaid free and clear any the s^d imposition.

An Act for the speedy payment
of Debts due to the Lord Proprietary.

Be it Enacted by the Lord Proprietary of this Province,
with the Consent and approbation of the upper & Lower
Houses of this Assembly, That all debts wh^{ch} either are or
shall be, from time to time, really and truly due to
his Lopp, or his Broirs Lords and Prop^ries of this Province
shall be first Payd and Satisfyd within the said
Province, before any other debts whatsoever.
