An act, ^{for} ~~concerning~~ Conveyance of all Letters Concerning the State & Publick affaires.

R
Be it enacted by the authority of this present
genl Assembly that all Letters whatsoever to, or
from the Goborne, or Goborne & Councill, or any of
his Lopps Counsellors or Justices of the peace touching
the publick affaires of this Province, shall (without
delay) be sent from house to house the direct way th
till they be safely delivred as directed: and every person
^{after receipt of such Letter,} delaying to carry the said Letters to the next house above
the space of halfe an hour, shall pay for a fine to y^e Lord
Prop^{rty} One hundred pounds of tobacco, unless it were
delivred so late in the day as it could not before night
be delivred at the next house; or that through violence
of winds or tempest it could by no means be sent obo
the Brook or River, if any chance to be betwix the
house where such Lett^e shall be delivred, and y^e house
to which it ought to be Conveyed.

And Be it further enacted that all public
Letters shall be subscribed by the person directing or send
ing the said Lett^e upon the outside of the said Letters.
