consent of the uppor and lower houses of assembly in
this present greate assembly of the ffroomen of this Pro
vincie assembled, that from and after the twenty ninth day
of Septembre, wh^e shall be in the year of our Lord God
1669, every mastor, Captain or Comand^e of any shipp
or vessell from tyme to tyme repairing or coming into
this Provinco, or any part therof to the intent to shipp
Load or fraught any goods or commodities within this
Provinco, or any the ports, Habens, Bayes, Ribors,
Crookes or other places thereto belonging, for the trans
porting of the same thence out off this Provinco, shall
within ffe^r dayes after such his or their arrivall in this
Provinco, & before his or their breaking of bulk, or lading
of any goods, commodities or merchandizes within this Provinco
or any the ports or places therunto belonging, give notice
unto the said Lord Prop^e, his heires & assignes, Lord an^o
Prop^e, or ^{or their Gouverne^r of this Provinco} Lords and Prop^e of this Provinco for the time
being, of such his or their arrivall, and of the Port or place
where such vessell shall so arrivo, together with y^e name
or burden of such ship or vessell, & the true port or place
for which the said ship shall be bound or shall be intended
to be bound when the same shall depart from this Provinco
And in case the said Lord Prop^e, his heires or assign^e
