

Lord and Prop<sup>t</sup>, or Lords & prop<sup>t</sup>s of this Province,  
or any other on his or their behalfe, or his or their Go-  
verno<sup>t</sup> or Governo<sup>t</sup>s of this Province for the time being  
or any on his or their behalfe shall within ten dayes  
next after his or their arrivall intimate unto such  
Master, Capt<sup>t</sup> or Comander his or their desire to shipp,  
fraught or load on board, and within thirty dayes  
after such arrivall offer or tender to be shipp'd, &  
fraughted or laden on board, in such ship or vessell,  
in such port or place where such ship or vessell  
shall be intended to be fraughted or laden, any goods  
or commodities being the proper goods and Commodities  
of the said Lord Prop<sup>t</sup>, or of such his heirs or assignes  
or of his or their Governo<sup>t</sup> or Governo<sup>t</sup>s to the intent  
to have the same transported out of this Province  
to such port or place, ports or places for which  
such ship or vessell shall be so bound, or intended to  
be so bound, That then in every such case, every such  
Master, Captain or Comander of every such ship or  
vessell shall, upon such desire or request shipp, fraught  
and take on board, and alsoe lade and stowe in some  
dry and convenient place of such ship or vessell, &  
not near or next unto the ballast of such shipp,  
or vessell such goods & Commodities, and give and  
signe true and just bills of lading for the same, &  
Carry and convoy the same unto and deliver of same  
at such port or place unto wh<sup>t</sup> such shipp or vessell  
shall be bound or intended to be bound when the same  
shall depart from this Province, (the danger of the  
seas only excepted), soe as such goods & Commodities  
soe desired or intended to be shipp'd doe not exceed  
the quantity
