

the quantity of one tun for every thirty tun of weight  
 such ship or vessell shall be, or shall be reputed to be  
 burthen, and soe as the person or persons that shall make  
 such request, or tender, doe at the time of such request or  
 tender to be made, agree to pay and allow such reasonable  
 and proportionable consideration & allowance by the tun  
 for the freight, carriage & transportation of such goods &  
 commodities as is or shall be usually paid or allowed or agreed  
 to be paid and allowed by other persons for the freight, carriage  
 & transportation of goods & commodities of the like nature and  
 quality from this Province unto the place or places for which  
 such ship or vessell shall be then bound or intended to be bound.  
 And likewise that every such master, Captain or Commander  
 who shall (from and after the said twenty ninth day of  
 Septemb<sup>r</sup>. wh<sup>ch</sup> shall be in the year of our Lord 1669) fail  
 or neglect to give such notice; or to shipp, freight, take on  
 board, load, stow or transport such goods & commodities of  
 his said Lord<sup>sh</sup>., his heirs & assigns, Lord & Proprietor  
 or Lords & Prop<sup>rs</sup> of this Province, or of such his or their  
 Govern<sup>or</sup> or Govern<sup>ors</sup> of this Province for the time being  
 or shall refuse to give such bills of lading  
~~according to the true intent & meaning of this present act~~  
~~shall for every such offence forfeit the sume of ten~~  
~~pounds sterling for every tun so refused, to the Lord~~
