

as aforesaid, according to the true intent & meaning of this present act, shall for every such offence, forfeit the sum of some pounds sterling for every sum so refused, to the Lord Prop^y. or Lords & Prop^{rs} of this Province, to be recorded in the Prob^{all} Court of this Province, and that untill such forfeiture be recorded & satisfied it shall and may be Lawfull to & for the said Lord Prop^y, his heirs and assigns Lord & Prop^y, or Lords & Prop^{rs} of this Province, or his or their Govern^r or Govern^{rs} of this Province for the time being, to seize & detain such shipp and vessell of w^{ch} such master, Capt^t or Com^{mander} shall be mast^r, Capt^t or Com^{mander}, with all her gums, tackle, furniture & apparrall whatsoever. This act to endure for three years, or to the end of the next gen^l assembly w^{ch} shall first happen.
