

as aforesaid, according to the true intent & meaning of this present act, shall for every such offence, forfeit the sume sume pounds sterling for every sume sume 100 refused, to the x Lord Prop<sup>ty</sup>. or Lords & Prop<sup>ts</sup> of this Province, to be recovered in the Prob<sup>ate</sup> Court of this Province, and that until such forfeiture be recovered & satisfied it shall and may be lawfull to & for the said Lord Prop<sup>ty</sup>, his heires and assignes Lord & Prop<sup>ts</sup>, or Lords & Prop<sup>ts</sup> of this Province, on his or their Gouverne<sup>r</sup> or Gouverne<sup>rs</sup> of this Province for the time being, to seize & detain such & shipp and boord of wh<sup>ch</sup> such Master, Capt<sup>t</sup> or Comander shall be mast<sup>er</sup>, Capt<sup>t</sup> or Comander, with all her guns, tackle, furniture & apparel whatsoever. This act to endure for three years, or to the end of the next gen<sup>r</sup> assembly wh<sup>ch</sup> shall first happen.
