

whereby (amongst other things) it is enacted, that no actions  
 shall or may be laid upon any the goods or Chattels of  
 of any Inhabitants within this Province, except the true  
 owners be not at that time resident or dwelling within this  
 Province; By colour of the authority of which act, (there being  
 no certain Rules prescribed for proceeding upon such at-  
 tachments), the Estates of severall people of this Province  
 have (in their absence out of this Province) been Condemned  
 & Levied, without the parties privity, or making any  
 defence by himself or his Attourney: and the said party  
 or parties soe absent are by the practice of the said seve-  
 rall Courts excluded & debarred from making any just  
 defence agt. y<sup>e</sup> s<sup>d</sup> attachm<sup>t</sup>, though issued out upon very  
 slender Proofs and securities, unless he or they, by him  
 or themselves, or his or their Attourney come within a year  
 and a day after the said Attachments issued out and make  
 such their defence, to the great prejudice, & (almost) utter  
 Ruine of many of the good people of this Province & much  
 trading in & thereunto. Wee doe humbly Pray that it  
 may be Enacted: and Be it enacted by the R<sup>t</sup>. honorable  
 the Lord Prop<sup>r</sup> of this Province, by & with the advice  
 and Consent of the upper & lower houses of this present  
 gen<sup>l</sup> assembly, that from and after the publication hereof  
 all and every person & persons whatsoever Inhabitants  
 within this Province; and all and every merchants trading  
 hither, and leaving effects here, that shall depart this Province  
 shall (before their departure) make, constitute & ordain one  
 or more Attourney or Attourneys for them, in all actions,  
 writts or plaints whatsoever to be brought against them  
 by any person or persons whatsoever, in any Court or  
 Courts
