

Livelyhood for tho future; but that Corn for necessary  
mantenance, Bedding, Gunn, Axe, Pott, & necessary  
Labourer's tools, with such like household implemants  
and ammunition, for subsistence, shall be protected &  
from all such attackments & exactions so long as  
he or they shall inhabite within this Province.

And Provided alsoe that such as shall be  
found (by proofe or other circumsta[n]ce) willfully to  
absent themselves into the woods, or other wheres from  
the Sheriff's sight; whereby they cannot be found &  
to be brought to tryall: and such alsoe as shall be  
intended to depart; or fly out of this Province; to be  
abjured upon oath; shall have no bonoffitt of this  
Law, but that an Attackment, or Execution may  
issue forth on all, or any of his goods or Chattells.  
This act to endure for three yeare, or to the end  
of the next genl Assembly w<sup>ch</sup> shall first happen.

An act providing what shall be good  
evidence to provi Forreigne Debts.

Whereas divers persons in the Kingdom of  
England, and other places, have (in their hands) Bonds  
of divers and sundry persons now residing in this  
Province, & send them to severall Attorneys to be  
put in suit agt the said Debtors here; w<sup>ch</sup> for the  
want of a Law to explain and ascertain what  
shall be a sufficient proofe & evidence for the  
probating the said Bonds to be the act & deed of  
the said
