*An act against Divulgiers of  
false News.*

Whereas many Idle and busie-headed People do  
forgo and divulge many false Rumors and Reports,  
to the great disturbance of the peace of the Right &  
hono<sup>rable</sup> the Lord Prop<sup>erty</sup>, and his good people of this  
Province.

Bee it enacted by the Right hono<sup>rable</sup> the Lord & xx  
Prop<sup>erty</sup>, by and with the assent of this present go<sup>ve</sup>  
Assembly, That what Person or Persons soever &  
shall forgo or divulge any false Reports, tending to  
the trouble of the Province; Lye; or they shall be, by  
the next Justice of peace, sent for, and bound over to  
the next County Court, or the Prob<sup>ate</sup> Court: where,  
if the thing related be materiall; and that he ~~do~~ produc<sup>e</sup>  
not his Author, he shall be fined 2000<sup>l</sup> Tobs: or less,  
if the Court shall think fitt to lessen it: and besides,  
givo Bond with security, for his behavour, if it ap-  
pear to the Court, that he did malitiously publish, or  
invent the same: One halfe to the Lord Prop<sup>erty</sup>, &  
the other halfe to him or them that shall inform of the  
same: to be Recovered in any Court of Record w<sup>th</sup> in  
this Province.

And further if any such Idle or busie headed  
person shall forgo; or malitiously publish, or invent  
any false Reports or falses of any of his Lord<sup>r</sup>s  
Justices of the Prob<sup>ate</sup> Court - shall by the Justice
