 Alsoe each person aboves named to have nine Irons numbered from one to nine: And another with a Cypher for the numbering off Stilliards and poa that they might not be Charged: And alsoe to procure Brass measures of Ell and Yard to be sealed in England. Likewise a sealed Bushell, halfe Bushell, peck and gallon of Winchester measure Gallon Pottle, quart, Pynt and halfe pynt of wine measure with three burnt stamps for the wooden measure and three other stamps with the peck measure to be all of the same Letter with their other stamps And that the said weights, measures and stamps be kept by the respective persons aforesaid at their aforesaid houses, whether all persons are to bring their stilliards to be tryed, stamped and numbered once a year: Alsoe their Barrels wth are to contain fivv Bushells, and other measures, to be sealed. And all persons selling by other weights or measures wth are not stamped, tryed, numbered and sealed as aforesaid shall forfeit one thousand pounds of tobacco for every default the one halfe to the Lord Prop^{ty} and the other halfe to the Informer to be recovered in any Court of Records within this Province.

And ~~Be~~ it is further enacted by the authority aforesaid that no Stilliards that carry gross weights shall be admitted or stamped at any Standard within this Province.
