

the Person aforesaid must see and be at in performing this
 office. It is hereby further Enacted by the authority aforesaid
 that every Person or Persons for any time that any Person shall
 have their Stilliards and Poa tryed, stamped and numbered shall
 pay unto such persons that shall have the keeping of the said
 Standard, the sume of two skillings, and also six pence for every
 woodon and Putox measure marked. And if any, without a just
 Cause, shall trouble another to try his stilliards, after marked and
 numbered by the Standard, such person shall pay and satisfy the
 fee to the Officer, ^{as} aforesaid. And it is hereby further
 Enacted by the authority aforesaid that, ^{sixteen hundred} ~~two~~ th tobacco to this
 present year Leaved in every severall and respective Counties
 within this Province, to be paid this Cropp now next ensuing
 unto each respective person aforesaid, for the purchasing
 of the aforesaid weights, measures and other the materials: and
 in case the same is not sufficient to purchase the same, after a just
 attempt delibered in to the Commiss^{rs} of each respective County of
 the first penny in England, with all other disbursements wth will
 annuo thereby, allowing one penny for every Pound of tobacco, then
 the said Commiss^{rs} are (thereby) enjoyned to take so much as shall be
 wanting therof in the ensuing County, Leavy. And if in case the
 said sume of 1600th tobacco will over, pay their said disbursements
 at one penny p pound, then such person or persons are to be
 accountable for the overplus, the next Cropp that shall ensue
 the arrivall of the said goods to the County that shall disburse the
 same: and if in case any of the persons aforesaid shall make
 default of Procuring and purchasing such weights, measures,
 scales, stamps and numbers by this act they are enjoyned by the time
 before limited
