

the Person aforesnamed must see and be at in performing this office. It is hereby further Enacted by the authority aforesaid that every Person or Persons for any time that any Person shall have their Stillards and Pea tryed, stamped and numbered shall pay unto such persons that shall have the keeping of the said Standards, the sum of two shillings, and also sixpence for every wooden and Pewter measure marked. And if any, without a just Cause, shall trouble another to try his stillards, after marked and numbered by the Standard, such person shall pay and satisfy the fee to the Officer^{as} aforesaid. *And it is hereby further*
Enacted by the authority aforesaid that ^{sixteen hundred} ~~1600~~ *tobacco to this*
present year levied in every sevall and respectivo County
within this Province, to be paid this Cropp now next ensuing
unto each respectivo person aforesnamed, for the purchasing
of the aforesaid weights, measures and other the materialls: and
in case the same is not sufficient to purchase the same, after a just
attempt delivered into the Comiss^{es} of each respectivo County of
the first pony in England, with all other disbursements w^{ch} will
arise thereby, allowing one pony for every Pound of tobacco, then
the said Comiss^{es} are(howby) enjoyned to take so much as shall be
wanting therof in the ensuing County: Loaby. And if in case the
said sume of 1600^t tobacco will over, pay their said disbursements
at one pony p^r pound, then such person or persons are to be ^pre-
accountable for the overplus, the next Cropp that shall ensue:
The arriball of the said goods to the County that shall disburse the
same: and if in case any of the persons aforesnamed shall make
default of Procuring and purchasing such weights, measures,
seales, stamps and numbers by this act they are enjoyned by the time
