

houses of this present gen<sup>l</sup> Assembly, and by the authority of the same, That no Person or persons whatsoever, from and after the beginning of this Assembly, shall import or bring into this Province, by sea or Land, any Horses, Geldings, mares or Colts from any foreign parts whatsoever, under the penalty of forfeiting all such horses, geldings, mares and Colts soe by him or them imported or brought, as aforesaid, on the full value thereof: one halfe to the Lord Prop<sup>r</sup> the other halfe to the Informer, on him or them that shall seize the same: to be Recovered in any Court of Record within this Province by Bill, Plaint, or Informacion; wherem no Exco<sup>m</sup>, Protection or wagen at Law to be allowed. This act to continue for three years or to the end of the next gen<sup>l</sup> Assembly w<sup>ch</sup> shall first happen.

An act for Explanacon of one Clause in an Act Entituled An Act prohibiting the ~~transportation~~ of all horses, mares, geldings and Colts into this Province, with addition and amondment therem.

Whereas at the first Session of this Assembly hold<sup>n</sup> at St. Marks the 27<sup>th</sup> day of March, in the 39<sup>th</sup> year of the dominion of Cecilus Amoz Dom. 1671, and there continued until the 19<sup>th</sup> day of Aprill then next following, for diverse reasons and Considerations to the Right hon<sup>ble</sup> the Lord Proprietary of this Province and the upper and Lower houses appearing, it was enacted and ordained by the said Lord Prop<sup>r</sup>, by and with the advice and consent of the said upper and Lower houses of the said Assembly, and by the authority of the same, That no person or persons whatsoever from
