

they shall think fitt, and in such manner as they shall think convenient: and that in case the said Servants Criminals shall remebe into any other County then where he was a servant and where the fact was committed, then it shall and may be lawfull for his Lordships Justices of the Provinciale Court at the desire and request of the Comiss<sup>E</sup>s of the respechto Countys to award such satisfaction to the said Comiss<sup>E</sup>s as shall be to them due from such servants Criminals as shall seeme meet. This act to continue for three yeares, or to the end of the next generall Assembly which shall first happen.

*An Act for* <sup>limiting</sup> ~~for the recovery of actions~~ *against the Surveyor genl. of this Province*

Forasmuch as the busyness relating to the office of Surveyor genl. of this Province of late yeares hath been, and now is soe great and lying soe diversly scituato within the soberall Countie of this Province that it is not possible for him to performe the same in his proper person as formerly it hath been wont to be performed but that of necessity soberall Deputys must be appointed, or otherwise the busyness of the Province cannot be done nor performed, for which performance as aforesaid it is impossible to prouide sufficient security of the respechto Deputy to bared harmles the Surveyor genl. from the erre<sup>E</sup>s, omissions and negligenc<sup>E</sup>s of the respechto Deputy, which erre<sup>E</sup>s as aforesaid the Surveyor genl. by the reason of the great distanc<sup>E</sup> between him and his Deputy cannot by any means prevent.

Be it therefore enacted by the Right hon<sup>ble</sup> the Lord Prop<sup>E</sup> by & with the consent of the upper and Lower houses -- of this present gen<sup>al</sup> Assembly, that the Surveyor gen<sup>al</sup> for the time being shall not in any waye be lyable for any erre<sup>E</sup>, defect, omission, neglect, or default of any of his Deputy Surveyors within this Province for any matter or thing whatsoever heretofore done or committid by any of his Deputy Surveyors, unless the party or parties grieved shall make complaint by suit or other formall process in Law, and continu the same without intermission -- until Judgement be thorow givin, and that the same be done within three moneths after the publication hereof. And for what
