

And if any such mother as aforesaid be able to prove by such testimony or confession of the party charged being a single person and woman did, before the betrothing of such child, promise her marriage, that then he shall perform his promise unto her, or remuneration her abuse, as the Court before whom such matter is brought shall see convenient, the quality and condition of this person considered. This act to continue for three years, or to the end of the next general Assembly.

An act against Burners of Fences.

Whereas divers of the inhabitants of this Province have suffered much damage by the notorious evil practices of ill disposed malicious persons burning their Fences, and no Law yet made for the deterring and punishing such offenders. For the preventing of such dangers and punishing such malicious attempts for the future, the good people of this Province do humbly pray that it may be Enacted, And

Be it enacted by the Right hon^{ble} the Lord Prop^{ty} of this Province, by and with the consent of the upper & lower houses of this present general Assembly, and by the authority of the same, that if any person or persons within this Province shall wilfully or maliciously burn or destroy any Corn field, Pasture ground, Orchard or other fence or fences whereby any of the inhabitants of this Province are harmed and damaged, the person so offending being therof convicted by the testimony of two sufficient witnesses shall suffer such penalties and undergoe such punishment as the Laws of England provide agt such malicious persons and practices of that nature, or ~~make~~ make restitution to the person wronged by paying treble the damage sustained thereby, as the Justices before whom such cause shall come, shall determine. This act to continue for three years, or to the end of the next general Assembly which shall first happen.
