

time being as aforesaid shall be lyable to satisfie all such debts, engagements and dammagos to the person or persons to whom such debt and dammagos respectiboly shall be due within this Province, unless the same be otherwise satisfid in convenient time, or that in one month he cause or procure such freeman to returne again into the Province, whereby he may be lyable to Justice here. And every such person as aforesaid as shall transport or convey away out of this Province any servant or servants being servants here by Condition for wages, Indentures or custome of the Countrey shall be lyable to satisfie and pay unto the Master or Owner of such servant or servants soe carryed away all such dammagos as hee or they shall make & appoare to be justly due unto such Master or owner for want of such servant or servants, as the Court before whom such Cause shall be tryed shall think fitt. And

Be it enacted by the authority aforesaid that the act made at a Sessions of Assembly hold at St. Marys the 21th Aprill 1650 Entituled An Act aganst Fugitives to stand repealed and is hereby Repealed for ever, and that one other act made at an Assembly hold at St. Marys the 25th of March 1671 Entituled An Act aganst Runnawayes & such persons as shall entertaim them, and others that travell without passos, and all and every the clauses and things therein contained doe stand, & is hereby Repealed and Continued This Act to continue for three years or to the end of the next year^{all} Assembly wh^{ch} shall first happen.

An act concerning what shall be allowed to the Grand Juries that are summoned twice a year out of the body of the Province to attend Provinciall Courts.
