that those persons that are summond upon the Grand Juries twice
year out of the body of this Province, shall from henceforth be allowed
for every Court that they shall see attord as Jurors Two thousand five
hundred pounds of tobaccoe for their Expe[n]ses & no more, and that every
County Leaby five hundred pounds of tobaccoe yearly to be payd to the
Ordinary keeper of the Countrey-houes at St. Marys that entertaines
them. This act to endure for three yeares, or to the end of the next
generall Assembly which shall first happen.

An act for Church Liberties.

Holy Church within this Province shall have and enjoy all her
Rights, Liberties and Franchisises wholly & without blamish.

An act providing against sudden accidents in the Government.

All Comissions from or under the Lord Proprietary wh[ich] shall be in force
at his death shall Romain in the same force, untill a new Commission for
the Government Published under the great Seale. And in case the Lieutenant
Governor shall decease or be absent out of the Province without nominating
or Substituting another in his Roome, the first Councellor of State
resideng at St. Marys shall exercize the office of Lieutenant Governor in
all points belonging to it untill his Returne into the Province, or that another
be appoynted by the Lord Proprietary.

An act concerning Religion.

Forasmuch as in a well governed Christian Commonwealth matters
concerning Religion and the honour of God ought in the first place to be taken
into serious consideration and endeavoured to be settled.

Be it therefore Ordained & Enacted by the Right hon^{ble} [unclear]
Lord Baron of Baltimore, absolute Lord & Proprietary of this Province
with the advice and consent of his generall Assembly that whatsoever person
or persons within this Province & the Islands thereto belonging shall from
time to time
