Be it enacted by y^e R^t Honble y^e L^d Prop^r, wth y^e adviso and
consent of y^e upper & Lower houses of this present gen^lle Assembly
that y^e aforesd Articles, dated y^e 20th day of Aprill 1666, be inviolably
kept & preserued, according to y^e true intent, purpose & meaning of
them, & for y^e perseruation of y^e people of this Province, & y^e honour of
his L^{ship} & y^e English Nation, wch will (undoubtedly) suffer by breach
of faith oben to a heathen.

Apr. 1666.

An act prohibiting the office of C^h & Sherriff
to be officiated, at one & y^e same time, by one & y^e same person.

Whereas it hath been found very prejudiciale to y^e Inhabitants
of this Province y^e divorce psons haue officiated both y^e offices of C^h
& Sherriff, wch hath occasioned many inconveniences.

Be it therefore enacted by y^e L^d Prop^r, by & wth y^e assent
of y^e upper & Lower houses of this present gen^lle Assembly, that, from
& affter y^e publication hereof no pson or psons whatsoever shall
officiate or holde both thos^e offices, either by himselfe, or d^esp^tly, wthm
this Province upon y^e penalty or forfeiture of tenn thousand
Pds of Cashed tobar, the one moyety to y^e L^d Prop^r, & y^e other to
y^e informer, wch shall be recovered by way of action, bill, plaint
or information, wherom no esigne, protection or wagen of Law
to be allowed.

An act for y^e publication of all Laws within this
Province for the future.

Inasmuch as many new Laws haue been made this present
gen^lle Assembly wherom y^e welfare of y^e good people of this
Province is much concerned, & divorce old Lawes, not sufficiently
providing ag^t y^e offendres by them to be punished, haue been made
more penall, to y^e end many people of this Province obilg
disposed may be deterred from obill doing: & notwithstanding that
all the Lawes intend that obory pson in this Province is bound
to take notice of what is passed in the Assembly, because obory
