or to make such entry, & shall not make or deliver a true and
just accomp or entry of or for any such monoy, goods, chattles,
commodities or merchandizes as aforesd, but shall conceale y^e same
such pson or ps ons, after proof theroff made, shall forfeit to
y^e L^d Prop^{ty} & his heires, all such monoy, goods, Chattles,
commodities or merchandizes soe concealed, & wheroff true & just
acco or entry shall not be made. And.

Be it furthor enacted by y^e authority aforesd That all and
obry pson or ps ons within this Province, who haue been, shall or may
be intrusted wth any monoy, goods, Chattles or merchandizes to or for
y^e use of y^e L^d Prop^{ty} or his heires, shall take his corporall oath upon
y^e holy Evangelists, to be administered by y^e Serretary or other officer
therunto appointed by y^e L^d Prop^{ty} or his heires, who shall haue
powre from time to time, by vertue of this Act, to minister y^e same,
if they think fitt, that all accomp or entries for any such monoy,
goods, Chattles or other merchandizes as aforesd, are true & just.

An act concerning trade with the Indians.

Be it enacted by y^e L^d Prop^{ty}, wth y^e conforst of y^e upper
& Lower houes of this Assembly, that from hence forward every
Inhabitant of this Province shall haue free liberty to trade with
any Indian or Indians within this Province for any Boabor or other
commodities, & to passe upon any River or Creek, or other passage
through any part of this Province to trade for y^e like commodities
with any Indian or Indians without this Province, & to export the
commodities or any of them so to be traded for from time to time, out
of this Province, Excepting Corn, wch shall not be exported out of
this Province without speciall leave for y^e same to be obtained from
time to time from y^e Lyout or chieff Gobernor^E of y^e Province, or such
other officer or officers for y^e time being, as he or y^e L^d Prop^{ty}
or his heires Lords & Prop^{ts} of this Province shall from time to time
appoint, paying a tenth in weight or value for all y^e Boabor soe
traded for, for a custome to his d^r L^d ship & his heires Lords and
Prop^{ts} of this Province. Provided that no pson or ps ons, who
