Bee it enacted by g<sup>r</sup> L<sup>e</sup> Prop<sup>E</sup>, by & w<sup>t</sup> h<sup>e</sup> c<sup>o</sup>n<sup>f</sup>ort off<sup>g</sup> upper  
& Lower houfes of this present gen<sup>a</sup>ll Assembly, That obry person that  
shall aduenture as a Souldier in any warr in g<sup>r</sup> defonco off g<sup>r</sup> Countrey,  
& shall therin happen to be maimed, or recei<sup>b</sup>e hurt, shall, according  
to his place & quality, recei<sup>b</sup>e maintenance from g<sup>r</sup> Countrey,  
according to his disability for maintaining himself.

An act concorning the setting up of a Mint.

Forasmuch as mony being the rule & meaure of g<sup>r</sup> value of  
Comodities, no trade or commerco can be well managed without it, & the  
want of it in this Province is a main hindrance to g<sup>r</sup> advancement  
of this Colony in trades, Manufactures, Towns, & all other things  
wh<sup>ch</sup> conduce to g<sup>r</sup> flourishing & happy estate therwo<sup>f</sup>. And the freedmon  
of this Province assembled in this present gen<sup>a</sup>ll Assembly doo humbly  
pray g<sup>r</sup> L<sup>e</sup> Prop<sup>E</sup> of this Province to take order for g<sup>r</sup> setting up of a  
Mint, for g<sup>r</sup> coyning off mony within th<sup>t</sup> Province, & confornt that it  
may be enacted, And

B<sup>t</sup> it enacted by g<sup>r</sup> L<sup>e</sup> Prop<sup>E</sup> w<sup>t</sup> h<sup>e</sup> c<sup>o</sup>n<sup>f</sup>ort of the upper and  
Lower houfes of this present gen<sup>a</sup>ll Assembly that g<sup>r</sup> mony so coyned  
or wh<sup>ch</sup> shall be coyned in the said mint, shall be as good silber as the  
currant coyn of English sterling mony. And that g<sup>r</sup> weight of obry  
shilling so coyned as afford<sup>d</sup> shall weigh above nine pence in such  
silber as afford<sup>d</sup>, & soe proportionably for other peeces of mony  
coyned in the said mint. And

B<sup>t</sup> it furthor enacted that obry offence of Clipping, scaling,  
Counterfeiting, washing or any way diminishing any Coyne soe to be  
made within this Province, shall suffer pain off death, & forfeit  
his or her Lands, goods & Chatteles within this Province to the Lord  
Prop<sup>E</sup> of this Province, & his heires, Lords & Prop<sup>E</sup>s of the same. And

B<sup>t</sup> it furthor enacted by g<sup>r</sup> auth<sup>z</sup> afford<sup>d</sup> that g<sup>r</sup> L<sup>e</sup> Prop<sup>E</sup>  
& his heires, Lords & Prop<sup>E</sup>s of this Province shall take & accept of  
g<sup>r</sup> Coyne in paymt for his Rent, Arrears of rent, & all other  
engagoments due unto him g<sup>r</sup> L<sup>e</sup> Prop<sup>E</sup> & his heires, Lords & Prop<sup>E</sup>s  
of this Province, according to this Act.
