

all all such times as they are out a Banging shall find their
owne Provision, But when in actuall Service then to be found
Provision all the Charge of this Province to be paid by the
Publike, & if it shall happen that any Troopers horse be killed
in the Service then the said Trooper to be paid for the said
horse by the publike & not otherwise.

That all preists Delegates Magistrates & Constables shall
in their proper persons be exempted from being Compelled to
muster & Draining either in horse or foot during such terms
as they officiate or beare such office as aforesaid, Provided that
this Clause shall not extend to such persons as already have or
shall hereafter accept of Commissions for Military Service from
his Majesty the Lord Prop: or his Maj: Gen: for the time being, soe as to
discharge such persons from their respective Charges mentioned in
such their severall & respective Commissions, neither shall this
Clause nor any parte thereof be Construed or taken to exempt
any Delegate Magistrate or Constable as aforesaid from sending
into the field to muster & Draining either horse or foot when
& as often as due notice or summons shall to them be given as
aforesaid some other person or persons in his or their stead & place,
soe provided or equipped as aforesaid upon forfeiture as aforesaid,
And be it enacted by the authority aforesaid, that all negroes &
slaves whatsoever shall be exempted the duty of Draining or any
other Military Service.

That the pay for the officers & Souldiers of the foot &
horse aforesaid be noe other then is hereafter mentioned, & for
noe longer time then such officers & Souldiers shall be in actuall
Service (to witt) to every Major Gen: being the chief Commander in
the field three thousand pounds of Tobacco y^e month, to every Col:
of foot two thousand pounds of Tobacco y^e month, to a Major of
foot twelve hundred pounds of Tobacco y^e month, to a Cap: of
foot one thousand pounds of Tobacco y^e month, to a Lt of
foot seven hundred pounds of Tobacco y^e month, to an Ensigne
six hundred pounds of Tobacco y^e month, to a Sergeant four
hundred pounds of Tobacco y^e month, to a Corporall four hundred
pounds of Tobacco y^e month, to a Drummer four hundred pounds
of Tobacco y^e month, And to every private Souldier three hundred
pounds of Tobacco y^e month, And that every Col: of horse have
three & twenty hundred pounds of Tobacco y^e month, & that a
Major of horse have fifteene hundred pounds of Tobacco y^e month,
And a Cap: of horse be allowed thirteene hundred pounds of
Tobacco y^e month, to a Lt of horse one thousand pounds of Tobacco
y^e month, to a Cornett nine hundred pounds of Tobacco y^e month,
