

Provided that noe Presse-master nor any other person or persons whatsoever, shall presume at any time to take seize presse or carry away from any Inhabitant Resident within this Province any Armes or Ammunition of any kind whatsoever, upon any duty or service upon any account whatsoever under the penalty aforesaid, any Law Statute or usage to the contrary hereof in any wise notwithstanding, And be it likewise enacted by the authority aforesaid & consent aforesaid, that the Commission: of any respective County Courts within this Province who shall not betwixt the ninth & twentieth day of September, & the said ninth & twentieth day of September, in each respective year, by precept from the County Court, signed by the Clerk of the Court, nominate & appoint such & soe many Presse masters for every hundred within their County as aforesaid, shall take of them for feite & pay unto the Right Honourable the Lord Prop: the sume of ffine hundred pounds of Tobacco, and such Presse masters who shall bee soe nominated & appointed as aforesaid by such precept as aforesaid to him or them directed, & shall hereupon Refuse or neglect to serve & duly & truly to execute & performe the said place & office of Presse master shall for feite & pay unto the Right Honourable the Lord Prop: for every time hee or they soe nominated & appointed as aforesaid shall Refuse or neglect to serve as aforesaid the sume of ffine hundred pounds of Tobacco.

And for the more & better Incuragement of such Souldiers as shall in time of warre venture in the service of the Country and defence thereof ag^t any Indians, Be it enacted by the authority aforesaid, that the free booty prize pillage or plunder or any Indians seized or taken Prisoners shall by the Commander bee equally distributed & divided amongst the Souldiers by a division & distribution to bee made by the Roll.

And for the Incuragement of such Souldiers as shall adventure their lives in the service & defence of the Province, and for a Provision of some reasonable pension, to bee for the future settled upon such Souldiers as shall happen to bee maimed & rendered incapable to gett a livelihood for themselves & family, Be it enacted by the authority aforesaid, that every person that shall adventure as a Souldier in any warre in defence of this Province, & shall therein happen to bee maimed or receive hurt soe as hee thereby bee rendered incapable of getting a livelihood as aforesaid, shall according to his disability receive a yearly pension to bee raised out of the Publique Treasury of this Province, for the time of such his disability, & every person slain in the service of the Province, & leaving behind him a wife & children,
