

taking the assets of Guardians or Trustees for orphans, but also for the Judge for probate of wills & granting administration in taking the assets of admors & executors to the benefit of others nor shall the Judge make any other allowance to any admor or admor upon his or their assets but for debts (bona fide) owing by the deceased & really paid or secured to be paid by the executor and respective administrators

2: **That** negroes or other slaves shall be sold or disposed of by any admor for payment of debts or otherwise & reserved for the admors own use in satisfaction for any debts due to the said admor nor any other secured upon any negroes or other slaves so long as there shall be other goods of the deceased sufficient to satisfy the just debts of the deceased but shall be kept upon the hazard of the estate and employed for the benefit of the creditors & orphans (if any be) during the first year at the end of which the admor is to answer for the estate & the profit of such slaves shall be divided as to the creditors & dividable between the wife children or relations of the deceased if there be not creditors

3: **That** no allowance be allowable for a yett blocked physician or education to any admor or Guardian to any orphan against the estate of the intestate or against the full parts of any child committed to any Guardian or other person intrusted by the County Court, but that the said orphans shall be maintained & educated by the interest of their estates & increase of their stocks so far forth as the said interest & increase will extend but if the estate be so small that it will not extend to a free education, such orphan shall be bound apprentice to some handicraft trade or other person at the discretion of the County Court, until one & twenty years of age except some kinsman or relation or other charitable person will maintain them for the interest of the small estate they have, without any diminution of the principal which shall always be delivered to the orphan at the years hereafter in this Act limited & appointed. Provide always that no orphan shall be put into the hands of any person of a different judgment in Religion to that of the deceased Parents of the said orphans.

4: **That** all cattle horses & sheeps shall be returned in kind by the Guardian or other person intrusted with orphans & stated what is to say so many horses cattle & sheeps as they pertained & of the same age as the cattle horses & sheeps were of at the time they were returned to the Guardian or trustee of the orphan.

5: **That** all money plate Rings & Jewells be reserved & not used by the Guardian or trustee & delivered in kind to the orphan when they come to age, & that all household stuff & furniture be appraised in money & not otherwise & the value thereof paid by the Guardian to the
