

8: That all that are Strangers for yeare or likewise returned in
Fines for the orphans at their full age (that is to say) the same
number of the same age & sex with the number of yeares to
strive of the same ability of body as were ab ran bee questioned the
Strangers when tried by the Guardian or Trustee.

9: That every Adm^r in his Inventory Jurateth what debts
are due to the orphans what are separate & upon what is allowed what
debts are separate the Judge for probate of wills shall transfer
these separate debts with the division of the over plus of the estate
unto the severall & respective Justices of the County Courts where
the estate shall lye to the end the said Justices may enquire whether
the said Adm^r have by fraud or otherwise neglected to returne the same
or have returned & used accounted for the same & shall with the
Residue of the estate commit the said separate debts to the care of
the Guardian or other Trustee by them employed & shall yearly and
every year shall the said Guardian or Trustee ans^r for the same &
duly suspect what of the said debts they have returned or might
have returned & if the said Guardian or Trustee faile to give in his
ans^r yearly or by fraud or Colours neglect or forbear to returne the
same the said Guardian or Trustee shall stand charged with and
accountable for every such debt by them returned & not accountable for
or neglected or forbore to bee returned.

10: That the Justices of the County Courts take able & sufficient security
for orphans estates & enquire yearly of the security & if they see just
cause that they require new or better security & upon Refusall to
give new or better security to remove the orphans estates into a
better hand & further that the Justices of the County Courts shall
yearly in June Court enquire by a Jury of twelve men whether
the orphans bee kept maintained & educated according to their
estates & whether apprenticed are yearly taught their Trade
or rigorously used or turned to Common labour at the age & how
instead of learning their Trade & if they find the orphans not
maintained & educated by the Guardians according to their
estate or the apprenticed neglected to bee taught their Trade
upon p^rsent that the last year is enough to learn the Trade
that they remove them to other Guardians & Masters respectively
And in case the Jury shall find that any apprentice is not taught
his Trade but putt to other labour as aforesaid the County Court
shall condemn the Master of said apprentice to make the appren-
tice full satisfaction as in Justice his yeares labour at other works shall
be five hundred pounds of cost more to bee paid to the said orphan.

11: That the Justices of the County Courts cause the Condition of the
bonds they take of Guardians or Trustees for orphans estates to bee
partly drawn according to this Act & recorded in their County
Courts & the Indentures for the apprenticed likewise that it may
duly appear to Jurys whether Guardians Trustees or Masters doe
right Justice to apprenticed & to the Country that the Justices doe
right betwene them & to that end that they cause the Clerk of
their Court to present the Jury with a list of the orphans & appren-
ticed of their County every June Court.

12: That not more bee allowed to Guardians or Trustees for collecting
