

and Bayle, & by Law Bayleable to dispece his Brunt att the Prox<sup>e</sup> Court of this Province who are to proctect ag<sup>t</sup> sum Criminales according to the Laws of England, & the Justices of the said County Courts are to bind over the partye Proctores to proctect att the said Prox<sup>e</sup> Court, & to send a transcript of the Records of the first recordes Conviction of the said Criminales vnder the Seal of the said County Court to the said Justices of the Prox<sup>e</sup> Court may appuron such punishment as the said Offense of sum person Criminales shall Justly deserve, & the same will allowe of, Provided alse that the Justices of the County Courts, & although they haue power to putt offend<sup>r</sup> into the Tally as aforesaid, yet they shall not haue power to dropp halfe yeare or miliate any member. This Act to endure for three yeare or to the end of the next Assemblies of Assembly, which shall first happen.

## An Act concerning Negroes & Slaves

Bee enstatuted by the Right Honourable the Lord Prop<sup>r</sup> of this Province with the Advice & Consent of the Upper & Lower houses of this present Gen<sup>e</sup> Assembly & the Authority of the same, that all Negroes & other slaves already imported or hereafter to bee imported into this Province shall serve (durante vita) all the children already borne or hereafter to bee borne of any Negroe or other slave within this Province & shall bee slaves to all intent & purpos as farr as wherefor the term of their naturall lives.

AN ACT for as much a directe freeborn English or white woman Insettled by the Justicarow Procurer, or Contravent of thier masters mistres or seruantes, & always to the satisfacion of thier said mistres & justfull desir<sup>r</sup>, to the dispart not only of the English but also of many other Christian Nations, doe intermarry with Negroes & slaves by nolesi means directe intercencencye there<sup>r</sup>: where<sup>r</sup> & suete may arise touching the issue or children of summe freeborn women aforesaid for the present whereop for the future, bee it further enacted by the authority aforesaid that if any Ma<sup>r</sup> or Dame having any freeborn English or white woman Servt as aforesaid in thier possession or property, shall by any Justicarow procurer knowldge permission or Contravent what soever suffre any sume freeborn English or white woman Servt in thier possession wherein they have property as aforesaid to intermarry or contract in matrimony with any slave from and after the last day of this present Session of Assembly, that then the said Ma<sup>r</sup> or Dame of any sume freeborn woman as aforesaid so married as aforesaid shall forfeite & loose all thier claime & title to the servit & seruitude of any sume freeborn woman, & also the said woman Servt so married shall bee & be by this present act absolutely distroyed & murthered & made free instantly upon her intermarriage as aforesaid from the servit & employement claime or demands of any sume Ma<sup>r</sup> or Dame for offending as aforesaid dide all children borne of sume freeborn women, & so many mistresses as aforesaid shall bee free to the woman so married as aforesaid as also the said Ma<sup>r</sup> or Dame shall forfeite the sume of Thirteen thousand pounds of Cobans, one halfe thereof to the Lord Prop<sup>r</sup> & the other halfe to him or them that shall informe & set for the same to be recovered in
