A Supplementary act to the acts for limitation of officers' fees.

Bee enacted by the Right Honourable the Lord Prop^r w^t his
advice & consent of the upper & lower houses of this present
Assembly by the authority of the same that notwithstanding within this
Province shall take demand ex parte or before any person or persons
whatsoever, for any receipt of or attendance upon any person whatsoever
being in his custody out house less than four & twenty hours, above
the sum of thirty five pds of zeb under the penalty contained in
the act for limitation of officer's fees, made at a session of Assembly
begun the fifteenth day of May one thousand six hundred & twenty
& six, & for the future no officer or officer in the said office particularly
mentioned nor any the County thereof within this Province (whom
fees are by an act of Assembly begun the twentieth day of October
one thousand six hundred & twenty & eight, limited) shall
by virtue of either of the said offices or cause to be levied among
debtors upon the body goods or chattels of any person or persons what
soever, for any fees in the said several acts contained
without first demanding or causing to be delivered at due & just time
of the fees to them due by the acts aforesaid understanding or mind
of such officer or officer as aforesaid to the person or persons from whom
such fees demand shall be made as aforesaid, in any officer or officer in
either of the said acts named shall ex parte & large demand or require
any fees for any matter touching copper or coppery, where the person
or persons so named, under requirement or before the same or shall
do any matter or thing directly or indirectly contrary to the true intent
& meaning of the said several acts shall lose & forfeite the several
penalties in the said several acts to be such as are contained in such manner
as in the said several acts is set forth & declared, provided that this act
nor any thing therein contained shall not be construed taken or adjudged
to barre or hinder any person or persons abovesayd from prosecuting any
action already commenced or hereafter to be commenced for breach
of either of the said acts, fit remedy of the penalty already incurred
being alwayes left to the common law notwithstanding, provided
also that no suit or action hereafter commenced for breach of
this present act or either of the aforesaid acts shall be brought prosecute
or sue after two years after the subsidence of this session of Assembly or
after two years after the cause of action.
