A Supplementary act to the act³ for limitation of officers' fees.

Be it enacted by the Right Honourable the Lord Loppe with
the advice & consent of the upper & lower house of this present
Assembly by the authority of the same that no Sheriff within this
Province shall take demand & part or receive of any person or persons
whatsoever, for any arrest of or attendant upon any person whatsoever,
being in his custody out hours less than four & twenty hours, above
the sum of thirty shillings per day, under the penalty contained in
the act for limitation of officers' fees, made at a session of Assembly
begun the fifteenth day of May one thousand six hundred & twenty
& six, & for the future not officer or officer in the jail or particularly
mentioned nor any the County thereof within this Province (unless
fees are by an act of Assembly begun the twentieth day of October
one thousand six hundred & twenty & eight, limited & settled shall
by virtue of either of the said acts ready or cause to be levied daily
returned upon the body goods or chattels of any person or persons whatsoever
for any fees in the said several acts limited & contained
without first inquiring or caused to be delivered at the just sum
of the fees to them due by the acts aforesaid understand or mind
of such officer or officer as aforesaid to the person or persons from whom
such fees demand shall be made as aforesaid, & if no officer or officer in
either of the said acts named shall make & large demand or receive
any fees for any matter or thing copy or copy, where the person
or persons concerned under requirement or receipt of the same or shall
do any matter or thing directly or indirectly contrary to the true intent
& meaning of the said several acts shall lose & forfeit the several
penalties in the said several acts to be such as are contained in such manner
as in the said several acts is set forth & declared, provided that this act
nor anything therein contained shall not be construed taken or applied
to debar or hinder any person or persons whatsoever from prosecuting any
action already commenced or hereafter to be commenced for breach
of either of the said acts, or the recovery of the penalties already incurred
by any thing herein contained notwithstanding, provided
also that for quicke & easie redēmption for breach of
this present act or either of the aforesaid acts shall be done & prosecuted
or sued after two years after the end of this present session of Assembly or
after two years after the cause of action.
