for and to the penalty of such fines as shall be by the Lord of the House of Assembly imposed upon them unless upon sufficient excuse to be admitted by the Lord of his Assembly in whose absence he dispensed with it any statute law or usage to the contrary thereof in any wise notwithstanding article 6. It is also enacted by the authority aforesaid of any Sheriff that shall refuse or neglect to make return of a Delegator so elected by Indenture as aforesaid before the day of the sitting of such Assembly or shall not make any indece or illegal returns of such Delegates shall for every such default be fined One hundred pounds, paying the same to the Lord Prop. the other to the Informer or Informer there of shall fine for the same to be recovered in any Court of Record in this Province whatsoever no Person or Doctor or Lawyer of Lawe to be allowed Provided nevertheless if this act or anything therein contained shall not extend to or be construed to exclude any County or County City or Cities Burrough or Burroughs herafter by the Lord Prop. of this Province his Heirs & Successors to be erected appoined & made with this Province from & excepted and Liberty of such Electors of Delegates or Representatives as is before expressed bid of such, with as aforesaid shall upon calling there of General Assembly for this Province for & future be issued to the Sheriff of every such County when the same shall be erected & made into a County as aforesaid to Maj. Recorder Alderman of any such City or Burrough commanding such Sheriff Maj. Recorder & Aldermen to cause four free men of the said County & two free men of the said City and Burrough qualified as in the said writ is expressed to serve as Delegates and Representatives of the same County City or Burrough with General Assembly hereinafter issuing to the four Delegates for every such County & two Delegates for every such City & Burrough shall from henceforth be accounted & esteemed to be members of the Lower house of the Gen. Assembly of this Province any thing in this act to the contrary notwithstanding notwithstanding. Provided also that no Sheriff or the Sheriff of this Province shall sit as a member of the Lower house of Assembly during the Term of this or the next Sheriffalty. Provided also if no Ordinary keeper within this Province during the Term of his keeping Ordinary shall be else chosen or serve as a Dep't or Representative in the Gen. Assembly so to be hereafter called Common Cappoyned as aforesaid
